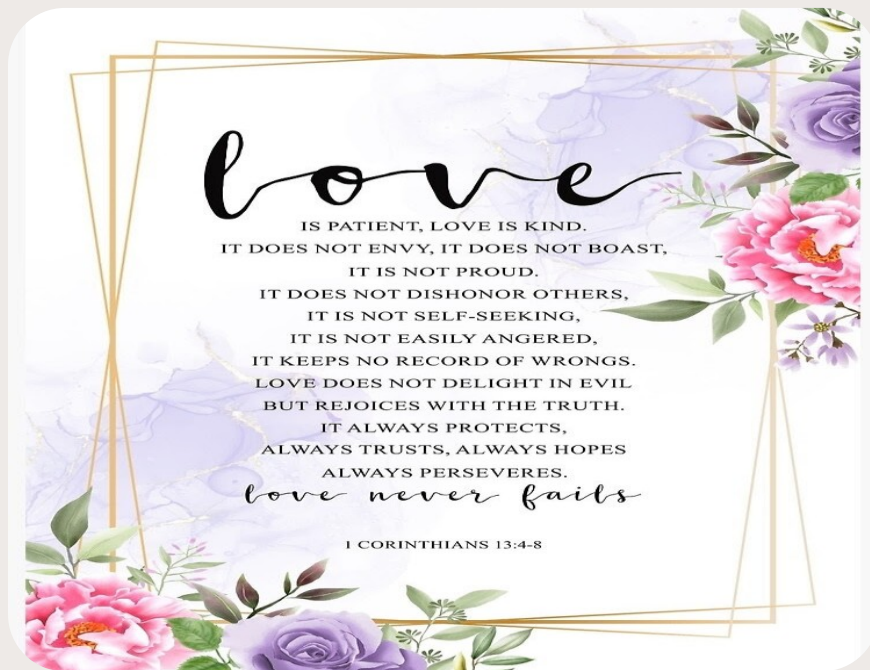

IN THE SPOT

How I Received the Holy Ghost

By God's grace, I was born and raised in a family of believers. I spent all my childhood going to church, prayer meetings, and message conventions, but it was not until we moved to England that I experienced the supernatural, and prayed through until I heard from God. My Pastor would preach on justification, sanctification, the baptism of the Holy Ghost, and adoption every week and at every opportunity. Although I believed it and prayed concerning these things much like other believers, it wasn't until I went to university and was out there on my own that something struck me.

One day, I remember waking up in a panic. Something was terribly wrong, and my heart was tugging heavily. I couldn't go home then, so I texted my older brother, asking if he could share what was being preached at home. He mentioned that they were studying the message 'A Paradox 1962.'

I shut myself in my dorm room. I would wake up early in the morning, prayed, sang, read the bible and listened to this tape repeatedly, all day. I sought the Lord with all my heart and soul and cried until I would lose myself in prayer. Nothing else in the world mattered to me, and I declared to him that he would find me dead in my room if he did not answer me. It was a matter of life and death, and even though I could not feel him, touch him, or see him, something in my heart knew that he was standing right there next to me and hearing every single cry.

About three months later, I got up to pray, and whilst listening to the tape 'Earnestly Contending for the Faith

Once Delivered' 1956, I opened my bible, and it went straight to Joshua 3:1-11. I was particularly struck by verse 5: "And Joshua said unto the people, sanctify yourselves: for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you." I knew right there and then that something was going to take place.

Shortly afterward, I packed up my bags and returned home for Easter. Little did I know, the Pastor planned to have Holy Ghost meetings that weekend. During the evening service on Saturday, March 26, 2016, we were singing, praying, and rejoicing as normal, and then the atmosphere changed. I remember the minister saying, "The angel is here. Jump in while the waters are troubled." I said in my heart, "This is my day," and I asked the angel to pass by my way and come into my heart.

I fell on the floor and lost consciousness for a while. Eventually, the mothers of the church raised me, and we were all rejoicing like never before.

One of the grandmothers said to me when we stood outside after service, "You received him just like we used to back in the day...the real Pentecostal blessing." I did not fully understand what she meant, but I know that the same Holy Ghost that they received in the 1980s and prior revivals is the same Holy Ghost that is with us today. Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Testimonies



On December 11th, 2024, I suffered a heart attack.

I was having some issues with my breathing for months, and I kept going to the doctor, and he kept

telling me I needed to lose weight.

I have been big most of my life, so losing weight didn't seem like something was all right.

I would try to walk, but it was difficult as I could not breathe properly. I returned a few more times complaining about the same issue, and he said the same thing. Anyhow, on December 10th, 2024, during the night, I started getting a lot of pain in my shoulders, and it started moving up to my neck and into my jaw.

I started reading up on Google what these symptoms could mean, and it said I was having a heart attack.

I did not want to believe it, so I went into the kitchen, had a yogurt, and decided to go back to sleep. I could not lie down, so I slept sitting up and probably got 2 hours sleep. I woke up, and it was time for work.

I got dressed and drove myself to work. During my time there, I still was not feeling the greatest, so I decided to leave work. I called my husband, and we ended up going to the hospital.

When I got there, they did the ECG and said it was normal. So, I told the nurse maybe it was

time for me to go home. She asked, "Did you have any blood work done?" I said, "No."

She then sent me over to get my blood done, and in about 20 to 25 minutes, I could hear her screaming my name.

At first, I thought something happened to my husband as he was with me, but we were not in the same room.

As she approached me, she asked, "Can you walk?" I said, "Yes, I can."

So, as we started walking, she was walking so fast that I could not keep up. So, I said I can't walk so fast.

She said I'm so sorry. Just come with me so I went.

She then put me on a bed and put on this equipment. I was very confused, so I asked what was going on. She said, "Oh, the doctor will be here shortly."

As the doctor came in, I saw them roll in with a whole bunch of needles and medication, so I asked what was happening.

She started explaining something about enzymes, and I said to her, "Can you speak in words I can understand? I don't know what that means."

Then she said with a very calm voice, "Mrs. Lee, you're having a heart attack."

At that moment, I became extremely calm. I looked over to my husband, and his eyes were closed.

They then started to work on me and admitted me that night to the hospital. They told me that I would have to go to another hospital as they did

not have the equipment to see what was going on with my heart.

I was then transferred and met with the doctors over at Sunnybrook Hospital, where they performed an angiogram.

It determined that there were five blockages in my heart, one at 100% that caused the heart attack.

The doctors immediately said this would require open heart surgery.

They transported me back to Humber Hospital, where I had to wait for the surgery date, which would be in a few days.

Anthony, the cardiologist, came to my room and sat down. I don't remember the exact time, but I believe it was the same time Perfect Love Tabernacle church was praying for me.

The doctor said he couldn't understand how I drove home, knowing well that I was having a heart attack or not knowing, but I still went home. He said, "You are so brave and so strong. I will be right back. I need to speak to Sunnybrook Hospital."

It took him about half an hour, and he returned and said, "Mrs. Lee. I do not want them to do open heart surgery for you, so I have made some recommendations, and they're going to try. You're going to be doing an angioplasty, which is not so aggressive, but it should clear the blockage in your heart."

"I don't know what that means, but praise God. Thank you so much, doctor. I appreciate your help."

My sister came later that day with a handkerchief and said, "The church prayed for

you." So, I took it and put it by my heart. I believe that God will do the rest, so I just believed.

When I went to the Sunnybrook Hospital, they performed the surgery, but before they did the surgery, they did the angiogram again, and I could hear the doctor saying, "Oh, the 100% blockage is now at 90%, which gives me a clear entrance to the vessel."

That was great news. He also mentioned that it looks like the vessels in her heart are stronger than we thought they were before. Also, there is not as much damage as we thought before.

They successfully performed the surgery and removed the blockage, and when it was all done, I took a deep breath. For the first time, I could breathe easily without effort.

The blockage was causing all the trouble in my body.

To date, there are four more blockages, which they will examine in March 2025. I trust God for full recovery; I know he's already done the job. He was working long before I even knew he was.

Thank everyone from Perfect Love Tabernacle and Brother Nelson for keeping me in your prayers. It means a lot to me. I know that God has already done the job.

Please stay tuned for part two of this testimony. God bless you richly.

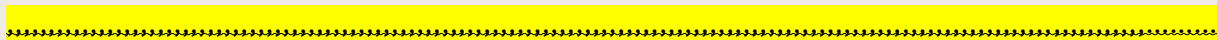
He Will See Me Through to the End

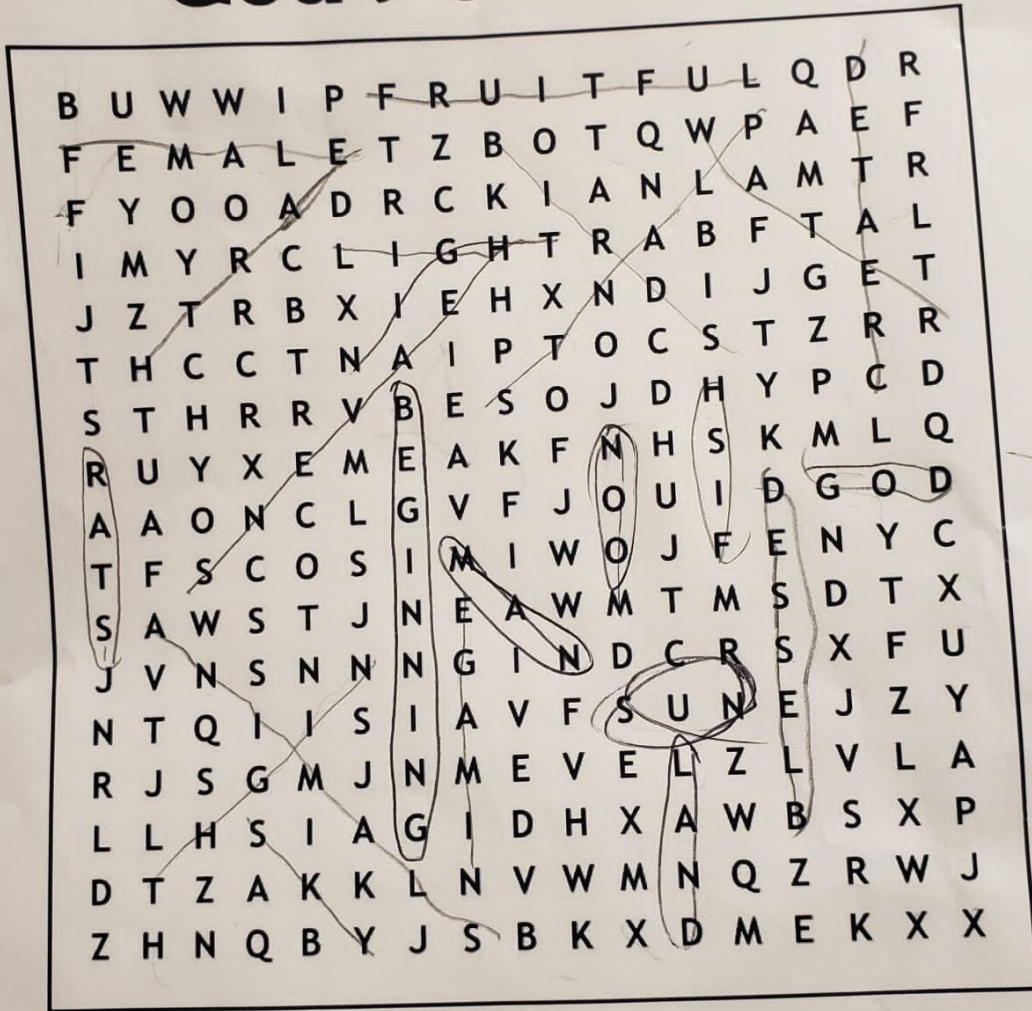
